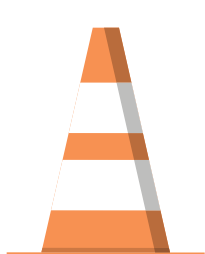

PREPARATION IS KEY

- **Customize your safety manual.** Address your company's specific needs and detail safety rules, procedures and standards of conduct. Review and update it regularly (at least once a year). 
- **Offer training programs.** Cover every stage and level of employment, such as general safety training for new hires and job-specific training, such as a driver safety course. 
- **Establish a behavior-based safety program.** Use the program to reward employees for practicing company policy. On average, the recorded workplace injury rate decreases by 29% in one year after implementing a behavior-based safety program – and 72% after five years.^{vi} 
- **Create an accident preparedness plan.** Define the immediate actions to take when an accident occurs. Include a list of necessary paperwork to complete following an incident, instructions for evaluating the cause of injuries and ways to establish corrective measures to prevent future accidents.
