PREPARATION IS KEY

Offer training programs. Cover every stage and level of employment, such as general safety training for new hires and job-specific training, such as a driver safety course.

of conduct. Review and update it reguarly (at least once a year).

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- Establish a behavior-based safety program. Use the program to reward employees for practicing company policy. On average, the recorded workplace injury rate decreases by 29% in one year after implementing a behavior-based safety
- program and 72% after five years.vi Create an accident preparedness plan. Define the immediate actions to take when an accident occurs. Include a list of necessary paperwork to complete following an incident, instructions for evaluating the cause of injuries and ways to establish corrective measures to prevent future accidents.
